ACTMEM actively aims to promote inclusive, creative and innovative approaches to storytelling among young people, so as to combat social isolation and reinforce their resilience in response to the certain difficult experiences such as Covid Pandemic. In this context, Each partner has launched the open calls to select the group of young leaders that will be trained together on **storytelling methodologies** to be able to test and replicate the methodologies within their local communities: we are looking for **young people** (18 - 27 years old) who want to **tell** their personal experience and story of social resilience (resilience stories about the pandemic but also about other challenges, environment, education, social inclusion, equal opportunities and social justice). We are looking for people wanting to **share** their experience in a creative way with other young leaders and communities from **Italy, Portugal, Bulgaria and Germany.**

Most of these activities will be developed in a **4-day meeting** in Italy (Arezzo, Toscana), where 40 leaders from 4 different European countries will meet to learn and exchange resilience experiences and storytelling methods.
